Ref: Public Consultation – Pike Management in Brown Trout Fisheries

This is a submission on behalf of Lough Carra Trout Anglers Association.

Lough Carra is predominantly a wild brown trout lake which covers an area of approx 1,560 hectares. It is one of seven lakes in Ireland that are designated managed wild brown trout fisheries in Ireland by Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI).

The present management of Pike in Lough Carra is carried out by Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) which involves the removal of pike by netting and /or elecrtic fishing.
