CONDITIONS OF TENDER

Any licence granted by IFI shall be on the terms of a licence agreement, as per paragraph 3 below).

- 1. The word fishery when used hereafter means fishing rights only (i.e. excluding bed and soil).
- 2. See List of Fishing Rights for Licencing in 2019, forming part of the Conditions of Tender (available on www.fisheriesireland.ie/State-Fisheries/state-fisheries-tender-process.html).
- 3. The form of licence to be granted to a successful tenderer shall be in form of the draft available on www.fisheriesireland.ie.
- 4. The licence will serve to grant the use of the fishing rights to the successful tenderer reserving such rights, including angling, to Inland Fisheries Ireland, their employees and agents, as necessary for the exercise of their statutory duties and rights under the Inland Fisheries Acts 1959-2010. To facilitate this, successful tenderers are requested to provide three club badges to the State Fisheries Manager which may be used to accommodate activities such as foreign journalist visits, fishery evaluations and site visits.
- 5. Tenders for the licence on the attached "Form of Tender" must state the licence fee offered per season. Where a multiple year licence is awarded this fee will be payable annually in advance.
- 6. A separate tender must be made for each fishery, and all tenders must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, marked <u>Tender for Fishery No-and forwarded to Paul O'Reilly</u>, Business Development, Inland Fisheries Ireland, 3044 Lake Drive, Citywest, Dublin 24.
- 7. The questionnaire forming part of these Conditions of Tender must be completed and any licence granted shall incorporate the reply to the questionnaire. The fishery shall be managed strictly in accordance with the terms of the licence and the contents of the questionnaire.



- 8. The latest date for receipt of tender submissions is June 7th, 2019.
- 9. IFI will not be bound to accept the highest licence fee offered or any tender.
- 10. Canvassing of Inland Fisheries Ireland officials in relation to a tender submission by any person or body corporate will result in any tender submission submitted by such person or body corporate being disqualified from the tender process.
- 11. IFI would draw particular attention to any tenderer applying for a licence for an IFI controlled fishery in 2019, that the Minister for Communications, Energy and Natural Resources ("the Minister"), pursuant to section 57 of the Inland Fisheries Act 2010 (" 2010 Act"), may introduce regulations and / or bye-laws which could, inter alia, close certain rivers for salmon angling, altering the period which is in any locality the annual close season for salmon or introduce a compulsory catch and release regime on certain rivers for salmon angling.
- 12. Applications for the granting of a licence will, inter alia, be considered in the context of the Minister's latest policy decisions and applicable statutory regulations and byelaws

- 13. In assessing tenderers' submissions prior to reaching a decision on the granting of licences, tenderers should note that IFI will give credit to applicants with the most open access policy, both in terms of:
 - a) providing permits at reasonable rates for visiting anglers; and
 - b) providing an open and transparent membership policy which gives equal opportunities to potential new club members

Credit will also be given to applications with the potential for the highest level of angling participation on the fishery.

A commitment from a tenderer to actively promote tourist angling on the fishery, including allowing the use of guides and ghillies will be given credit.

- 14. A tender submission by a body corporate shall be executed by the Company's Seal affixed in accordance with its Constitution.
- 15. A tender submission by a partnership shall be signed by one of the partners for and on behalf of the partnership and shall state the names of all the partners.



- 16. A tender submission by an organisation, angling or otherwise, shall be signed by its officers or trustees for and on behalf of the organisation.
- 17. The licence fee shall be payable in advance for each season. The licence will be subject to revocation if the fishery is not being managed in accordance with the terms of the licence or if the licence fee is not paid. Any outstanding fees owed to IFI in respect of previous licence tenders must also be settled in advance of application for the 2019 season.
- 18. The licence may be terminated by the licensee or IFI on giving three months' prior written notice.
- 19. Licensees must complete an "end of year" report on a licenced fishery (in the format approved by IFI) and return it to IFI within one month of the expiry of the fishing season. A subsequent licence application will not be considered unless these reports have been properly completed and submitted to IFI within one month of the expiry of the fishing season.
